SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS:

Please send digital proposals to Women's Work curator Zakiyah Stewart (zbree16@gmail.com). Proposals must include the artist's name and title of work on all images (no more than 10 works can be submitted) and an artist statement of no more than 300 words. Artist statement must answer one of the following questions: *How has your identity as a woman influenced your art practice? In what ways has your practice helped you address gender inequality and stereotypes in the arts?*

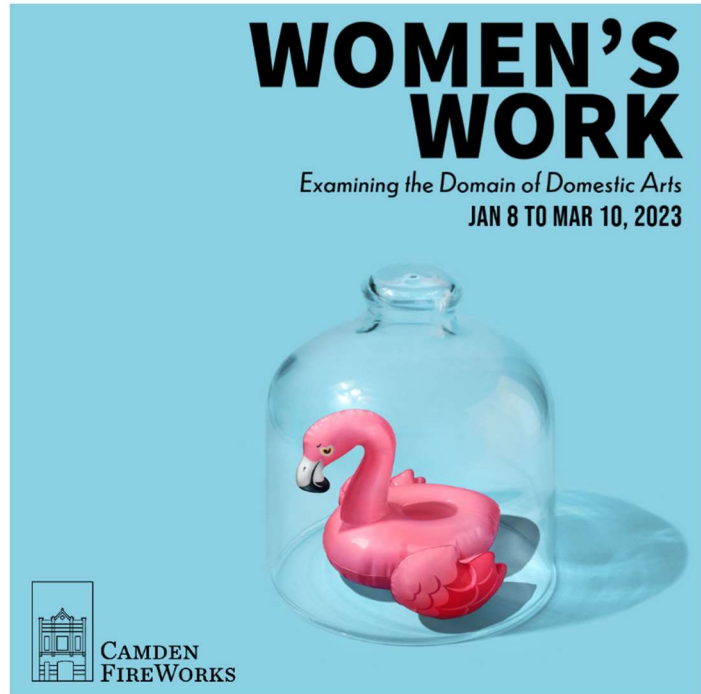
ABOUT FIREWORKS:

Camden FireWorks opened in Camden, NJ in June of 2016. Camden FireWorks' mission is to use art to create social change. As the only independent art gallery in Camden, New Jersey, it has featured artwork from diverse artists representing a variety of disciplines. In addition, it offers studio rentals, art workshops, and hosts exhibitions and cultural performances in its 1889 firehouse.

ELIGIBILITY:

This exhibit is only available in-person. The artist must be able to deliver their artwork to Camden FireWorks.

Women-identifying artists, age 18 years and older, residing in the following Mid-Atlantic states: Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania. Original artworks in any visual media may be entered. No reproductions or works shown in a previous Camden FireWorks exhibition will be accepted. Sculptures must be one piece. Final determination of what constitutes eligible work or inappropriate subject matter will rest with Camden FireWorks, Inc. Submission of an entry to this exhibit constitutes agreement by the entrant to all conditions set forth in this prospectus.



SIZE REQUIREMENTS:

Outside dimensions on 2D or 3D artwork may not exceed 48' in any direction and must weigh no more than 50 lbs. Work will be measured by gallery staff during hand delivery on December 17th and 18th.

PHOTOGRAPHING WORK:

1. Images of artwork should have no visible background or frame
2. Artwork under glass should show no reflections.
3. If photographing 3-dimensional objects or jewelry, place them on either a white or black non-textured background.
4. Images should be in JPG, PNG or PDF file format.
5. If your image file size is greater than 5MB, use a photo or image editing program to reduce the size of the image before emailing to the curator.

Camden FireWorks, Inc. reserves the right to reject artwork that does not meet size requirements, is not photographed correctly, or reflects poorly on the artist and the Gallery.

PRESENTATION:

- Work on paper must be framed and under glass or Plexiglass. Gallery wrap canvas is accepted.
- Only wire hanging is accepted. No sawtooth or single eye hooks.
- Extremely fragile works will not be eligible due to the need for special handling.
- Work should be dry and fixed. No wet pieces will be accepted.
- Collage elements must be secured or protected behind glass or Plexiglass.
- Wall hanging fabric works will need to include a hanging device, such as a casing sewn with a dowel or rod included.
- Sculptural work and freestanding pieces must be in one piece and installation ready. Artists may be called to assist with installation, if necessary.

Work submitted without compliance to guidelines will be rejected.

RECEIVING OF WORK:

Artwork must be hand delivered to Camden FireWorks, 1813 S Broadway, Camden, NJ 08104. Work will be accepted Friday, December 17th, 12pm-5pm or Sunday, December 18th, from 11 am - 1pm.

SALE AND REPRODUCTIONS:

Works must be for sale. The exhibiting artist will receive 65% of the sales price for work that is sold.

Camden FireWorks reserves the right to photograph and reproduce any artwork for promotional purposes. The copyright remains with the artist.

RETURN OF ENTRIES:

Unsold artwork may be picked up on Saturday, March 11, from 10 am - 3 pm.

CHECKLIST:

1. Apply and submit photographs *no later than 5 pm on November 10, 2022*.
2. Drop off art at Camden FireWorks Friday, December 17th, 12pm-5pm or Sunday, December 18th, from 11 am - 1pm.
3. Attend opening reception Sunday, January 8th 3 – 5 pm.
4. Pick up work Saturday, March 11, from 10 am – 3 pm.
